## INSTRUCTIONS

*Please read these instructions carefully and ensure full compliance before submitting your materials.*

All materials must be uploaded to the online application on **Screen 7** and submitted no later than the deadline date at **12:00 noon (CET)**.

- All materials must be submitted as direct web links (URLs) **with their corresponding passwords**, if applicable. Materials may be hosted on Vimeo, Dropbox or Google Drive (or any other file-sharing or cloud storage platform).  
**Do NOT upload PDFs directly to Screen 7.** These will not be accepted and will not be forwarded to the external experts, who are evaluating the projects.
- To ensure the anonymity of the experts, links that require login, account creation, an email address, or a name to access the content **will NOT be accepted**. Please check access settings carefully and test your links in an incognito window before submitting, to **ensure they are accessible without logging into the platform/website**.
- All links and passwords **must remain valid until the evaluation meeting** at which your project will be examined ([see evaluation meeting dates here](#)).
- For Vimeo links: Please apply a content rating to your video and select **"All Audiences"** ([see instructions here](#)). Videos without a content rating will not be accepted. **Do NOT use the "Mature/Adult" rating**, as videos with this classification cannot be viewed without a Vimeo account.
- For YouTube links: Please ensure that access to **the video is NOT restricted to specific countries or regions**.
- All materials must be submitted in **English (or with an English translation/subtitle, as applicable)**. If possible French versions or French subtitles may also be provided but are not required.
- Please **do NOT modify the link or the contents of a Dropbox, Google Drive, etc. after submission**. Do not change access settings, make the folder private, or add/remove items.
